What are the directions for PROSACEA Gel?

Apply a thin layer of **PROSACEA Gel** to the affected area one to three times daily. Massage gently until absorbed into the skin. Be sure to read all product package label Directions, Uses and Warnings and follow them carefully.

Is PROSACEA FDA approved?

PROSACEA is a homeopathic product and homeopathic products are permitted by FDA regulations.

Can I use make-up, moisturizers or sunscreen with PROSACEA?

Yes, you can use make-up, moisturizers or sunscreen with **PROSACEA**. However, we recommend that you wait approximately 15-20 minutes after applying **PROSACEA** to let it dry and adsorb into the skin before applying make-up, moisturizers or sunscreen. We also recommend you consult a doctor or dermatologist for questions and recommendations on the appropriate cosmetics, moisturizers and sunscreens which may be used along with **PROSACEA**.

What is the expiration date for PROSACEA Gel?

Because **PROSACEA Gel** is a homeopathic product, it is not required to carry an expiration date. However, we do monitor the physical integrity of the product for five years following the date of manufacture. What is the active ingredient in PROSACEA Gel?

PROSACEA Gel contains sulphur 1x.

What is the difference between the sulphur in PROSACEA and sulfa drugs?

The sulphur in **PROSACEA** is a mineral and sulfa is used to describe a class of antibiotics.
